January Series: "The Heart of the Matter: What Are We Doing Here?"

I remember taking a philosophy class during my undergraduate studies. The professor was

a PhD student at Vanderbilt, and he's clearly a brilliant guy. He would sit and lecture with his

feet propped up using very little (if any) notes. I remember it being a fascinating class, and I

even contemplated making philosophy my major. Because what could be more important

than contemplating the most fundamental questions in life? "What is the meaning of life?"

"How do we know what is right and good and true?" "What is the basis of knowledge and

reality?"

These days, there are lots of pseudophilosophers who purport to know the answers to these questions. Many of them have been able to amass a following of some sort. They sell tons of books and tickets to speaking events. and they promise that they have probed the depths of the essential matters of life.

In the biblical book of Ecclesiastes, we are introduced to one such character called "Qohelet" in Hebrew. His pseudonym literally means, "Assembler," but is normally translated as "Teacher" or "Preacher" in most English translations.

In many ways, Ecclesiastes (the Greek form of "Qohelet") is his biography. Qohelet is a wise philosopher. He is learned, wealthy, and powerful. But his frantic search for meaning, purpose, and fulfillment only ends up in frustration. As Qohelet ponders the answers to life's big questions, he turns up empty answer after empty answer. Qohelet desperately attempts to make sense of a world apart from God, and he fails dramatically.



But there's another voice speaking in Ecclesiastes. It's the biographer's voice, the voice of one who holds up Qoholet's life to us as an example to learn from. What we will see is that the biographer has more wisdom than Qoholet, for he sees the futility in trying to live fully in a broken world that is not our home.


