- Can share his or her faith and answer student questions about faith.
- Is coachable and flexible.
- Enjoys working with teenagers and young adults.
- Has experience leading Bible study and working with students.
- Ability to react appropriately under pressure, apply good judgment, use sound decisionmaking; problem-solving skills in a deadline-driven environment.
- Possesses strong organizational skills, with the ability to adapt to changing priorities and meet expected deadlines; pays attention to detail.
